Proximal Humerus fractures are common and represents a challenge in the evaluation and management of these injuries. If operative treatment is selected, unique treatment challenges must be overcome, including obtaining and maintaining reduction of small bone fragments with strong muscle forces. In modern times, osteoporotic bone quality further increases the difficulty in treating these fractures.

In the context of the current course concept with fractured specimens and intact soft tissue envelope, you will address the bony stabilisation techniques and possibilities of soft tissue reconstruction.
