4.	Legal basis for the data processing	Declaration of consent pursuant to Article 9 lit. 2a GDPR / UK GDPR

6.	Transfer to a third country	No transfer of data to a third country is intended.
7.	Period for which the personal data will be stored	The data will be stored for as long as the purpose of use and your consent remain valid only. Patient data will be retained by Medartis for a period of twenty years after the sale of the product to the customer in order to comply with legal obligations.
8.	Rights of the data subject	<p>Subject to statutory conditions, you have the following rights under Article 15 to 22 GDPR:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The right to receive information about the data processing; • The right to a rectification or addition of data • The right to an erasure or blocking of data. If statutory storage duties exist, only blocking is possible; • The right to restrict data processing • The right to object; • The right to data portability, i.e. to receive data in a machine-readable format, and the right of transfer of data to another controller.
9.	Right to withdraw consent	If data are processed on the basis of your consent, you may withdraw this consent by means of a simple declaration to the controller which will be effective in the future. Due to the statutory retention obligations your data will be blocked during 20 years and thereafter deleted. If you revoke your consent, there will be no negative consequences for you.
10.	Right to lodge a complaint to a data protection authority	Pursuant to Article 77 GDPR, as a data subject you have the right to lodge a complaint to a supervisory authority if you believe that the data processing is in breach of data privacy legislation.
